Definition: In two or three sentences, explain the idea you want to address.

Competence: State several learning outcomes. What ability or insight do you hope to gain?

Methods of Investigation: What methods will you use to gather information? From what sources will this information come?

Coherence: How will your work be organized? Will your evidence, definitions, concepts, and analysis be linked to your main point?

Standards: How will your evaluation group know that your work has sufficient depth? What standards will you use?

Product: Describe what the project will look like. What sort of document, artifact, evidence, etc, will your evaluation group assess?

NOTE: It is important to develop and negotiate your with your assessment group prior to embarking on your project.
